LIFELINE UKRAINE PROVIDES HUMANITARIAN AID DIRECTLY TO THOSE MOST IN NEED IN UKRAINE IN THE FORM OF CIVIL MEDICAL GOODS, BABY FOOD, DIAPERS, FOOD, AND NON-FOOD HUMANITARIAN AID.

LifeLine Ukraine:

- Makes weekly, end-to-end deliveries, through its own secured supply chain.
- Provides demand-driven aid, based on needs as identified by doctors, hospitals, local humanitarian agencies, and local governments operating in the field.
- Supplies the humanitarian goods to those in need within 14 days counting from the moment that the specific needs for these goods were identified.
- Certifies its supply chain through photo and video documentation.
- Has zero overhead.
- Meets needs others cannot, through a direct and nimble approach.
- Does fundraising and procurement of goods through the officially recognised charitable institution, the Mara Foundation.
- Will operate until 31-12-2022.

- *Medical Supplies: The need for medical supplies is updated on a weekly basis, and includes antibiotics, painkillers, bandages, gauze, etc.
- **Food: Pasta products, Sunflower oil, Different groats, Flour, Sugar, Instant noodles, Canned food, Coffee, Tea, Cookies, Candies, Sausage, Processed cheese, Hard cheese, Energy drink
- ***Baby Food: Infant formula and baby food (dry baby food for as long as there are subzero temperatures in Poland and Ukraine)
- ****Disposable Tableware: Deep plates, Small plates, Spoons, Glasses

Since the beginning of March 2022, four 21-ton EURO Trucks with medical supplies, baby food, food, diapers, hygienic products for babies, and humanitarian supplies were already delivered to Mikolayev, Ukraine and distributed to doctors, and civilians in need.
